1. Policy Scope:

This policy applies to all individuals from whom Composites Australia Inc. collects personal information, as governed by the Privacy Act 1998 (Cwlth).

2. Purpose

Composites Australia Inc. is committed to collecting and using data in a transparent and responsible manner to support the purpose of the organisation, outlined in its Constitution which are to:

- Responsibly maintain the market for and promote the increased use of Composites products.
- Represent members' interests to members of Parliament, Federal, State and Local Governments and regulatory authorities, insurance companies, consumer organisations and the media, to ensure fair and equitable treatment of composites products.
- Develop a high standard of product quality within the industry.
- Develop a high standard of commercial ethics amongst members.
- Actively promote development of the skills base of the industry.
- Provide a forum for discussion by members on subjects of common interest.
- Liaise with other relevant industry groups and institutes, both within Australia and overseas.
- Keep members informed on matters affecting the industry.
- Responsibly do what may consider necessary for further development of the Australian composites industry.

3. Data Collection and Use:

Member data is collected with explicit consent and used solely for advancing the objectives of the organization, as outlined in the Constitution. Members may revoke this consent at any time through written notice.

4. Aggregated Data:

Composites Australia Inc. may compile aggregated data from member inputs for industry analysis and advocacy. This aggregated data, which becomes property of C.A., is used to support SMEs and identify industry trends and capacities.

5. Confidentiality:

Composites Australia Inc. is committed to safeguarding member data confidentiality and security, implementing reasonable measures to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure.

6. Compliance:

Composites Australia Inc. adheres to the Australian Privacy Act and relevant state-based legislation, ensuring lawful and ethical data collection and usage.

7. Access and Correction:

Members have the right to access and correct their data entered in the Composites Australia Inc. membership database. Requests for access or correction should be made in writing to Composites Australia Inc.
